- **Bath Abbey**, on Tuesday 17th December

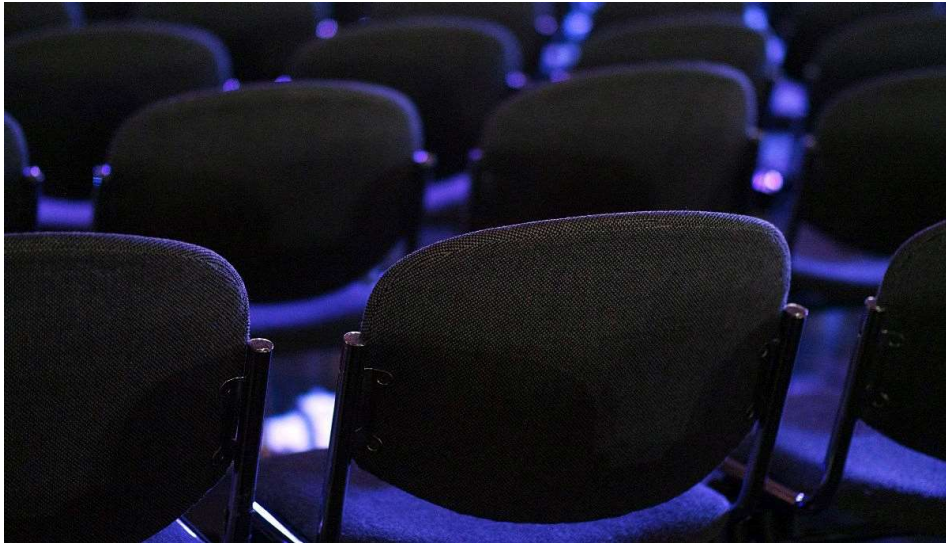
The webinars are from 7 to 8pm, and on Zoom.
