World Heritage Webinars - Val de Loire WHS

The next webinar introducing the **European Network of World Heritage Associations** (ENWHA) will focus on France's Loire Valley.

World Heritage UK is a member of the ENWHA which is a union of associations and initiatives that regularly exchange information and experience about the World Heritage. Their aim is to raise general awareness of European World Heritage, to advocate its protection and conservation, and to discuss common issues and topics using an open and transparent approach.

The webinar runs **6 to 7pm GMT** (or 7 to 8pm CET), and is on Zoom. Zoom details are usually sent out the Monday before the webinar.

Single webinar tickets are £5 each. A series ticket for all 5 webinars is £20. Tickets are available up to 4pm the day before.

Each webinar is recorded and uploaded to WHUK's private YouTube channel. All ticket holders will be sent a link to the video, to revisit or catch up if the live talk was missed. Series ticket holders will have access to all five videos.
